

10-Year Millage Renewal

- 10 mills = \$290,000
- Funds more than 90 percent of district's annual budget
- Millage first passed in 1984 to create the district

This in NOT a new tax!

Professionally Equipped


- Operate parish's ONLY aerial ladder truck
